Payment of Fees and Charges:

- 1 Where a student withdraws or suspends study from a course during the year, Tuition Fees and Maintenance Charges will be charged according to the College's enrolment and registration policy.
- 2 Tuition Fees can be paid in full at the start of the academic year and a discount of 0.5% will be given if fees are paid by 20 October (the discount does not apply to Student Loan payments or one-off charges). Alternatively, payment of Tuition Fees can be spread over 3 equal instalments, to be paid by 20 October, 20 January and 30 April, unless otherwise agreed.
- 3 Any part-payment of instalments will be used first to clear any Maintenance Charges and then Tuition Fees. Unpaid fees will be dealt with according to the student fee debt collection process. Failure to keep up with the schedule of payments may lead to a suspension of enrolment from studies after 90 days.
- 4 Fees and Charges shown are applicable only for the current academic year and are likely to rise, normally in line with inflation, in future years.

Notes:

- a This is the maximum charge; an application for RPL which is not complex may be discounted by 50%.
- b It is an expectation that students' placement providers carry out their own checks. Otherwise; annual subscription to the DBS Update Service is also required (£16 in 2024/25 but subject to change). The DBS check charge is reduced to £50 where the student already subscribes to the update service, and a full DBS check is not required.
- c If change of mode is agreed before 31 May in the prior academic year, this will be discounted by 50%.
- e Where a student is studying a reduced number of modules, an annual charge is made as an addition to the pro-rata tuition fee for the modules studied.
- f Where a student trails a 30-credit module from the previous level, into the next level a charge is made. When this charge applies there is no additional tuition fee for the trailed module.

Additional South West Regional Centre charges:

For students whose placements are set up through South West Youth Ministries (SWYM), some additional costs are met by the student's supporting Placement Partner. These include the cost of accommodation and meals at study block weeks held at South West Regional Centre. Any students whose placements are not set up by SWYM will be charged for study block accommodation and meals as used.
